

The Civil Engineering Programme Advisory Board (PAB) Meeting of the College of Engineering for Semester 1 of the academic year 2022/2023 was held on 6/12/2022. Dr. Hamdy Alsayed, Programme Director of Civil Engineering, organized the meeting and invited the PAB members to attend in person. Dr. Mohamed Salama, acting dean, Dr. Marwan Aouad, acting Vice Dean, and Dr. Wael Abdelhameed, HoD, welcomed all the board members. The meeting was chaired by Ms. Reem Al Otaibi from GPIC with the participation of board members; Mr.John Barnes, and Mr. Ahmed Al Jabri, Group HR & Administration Manager, NASS Contracting. All the staff members of the College of Engineering attended the meeting.

The advisory board members discussed various issues related to the delivery of the academic programme of Civil Engineering, and provided guidance, knowledge, and skills as it pertains to their civil engineering expertise. The colleagues from the College of Engineering discussed the status of the post COVID-19 teaching practices, assessment, and exams, graduation projects, and the college and ASU's events (Conference, QS, accreditation, and LSBU visit). Dr. Hamdy Alsayed shared with the participants the students' positive experience of the four site visits during this semester. The students' internship opportunities were also discussed, and the PAB members offered numbers of placements for the civil and architectural engineering students. The PAB members discussed extensively the current and future skills required by the commercial and professional sectors, and job opportunities for ASU graduates. In addition, proposals to develop the programme, the intended learning outcomes, and graduate attributes were introduced in the meeting.




"Funded Research Projects Seminar"
